01	Initiate trial	Fill out the Meraki <u>free trial form</u> . After submission, Meraki will reach out to you.
02	Intake form	Next, fill out the trial intake form. You will receive an order number which has a vMX license key.
03	Claim vMX	Claim the license key you received via email in your Meraki dashboard organization.
04	Create network	Go to the Meraki dashboard and create a network. Set vMX as security and SD-WAN appliance and generate your authentication token.
05	Deploy vMX	Log in to your cloud service provider dashboard. Deploy your vMX and apply your vMX authentication token to onboard.

- ☐ Connect up to 750 branches to a single vMX
- Connect services across regions within a single cloud service provider to a single vMX
- ☐ Connect services across cloud service providers to a single vMX
- Standardize and automate network configuration and security policies across your entire SD-WAN fabric
